Sportfishing In The Tropics



A FIRST-TIME SW BOATWORKS customer from St. Petersburg, Florida, liked the company's Young Brothers hulls so much that he put in an order for a 45-foot sportfishing cruiser.

Hey Jude launched in October and sped off to the Gulf of Mexico, where the owner is happily casting for mahi-mahi and other delicacies of the deep.

The owner loved the boat's downeast styling and roomy interior. He enjoys bringing his family on extended fishing trips, so the yard provided comfortable accommodations that include the forward stateroom, two bunks, closet, full head and galley, lovely cherry trim, and a full Soundown package. The slender 3:1 ratio and cored hull leverage power from the C-18 Caterpillar diesel, which gallops at 1,150 hp to achieve 23 knots cruising and 28 knots with the throttle down.

"He has the length, plenty of room forward for his fo'c'sle and living quarters, and plenty of room out back for fishing," said boatbuilder Stewart Workman. "And he loves the speed, stability, and fuel efficiency."

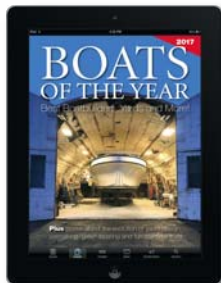
